USDA grant for the Community Center was resubmitted this week.

Hardee County Economic Development Authority Meeting was held Tuesday morning. The Board approved the agreements on the grant applicants that were approved at the last meeting. The Recreation Grants are now available for application for the local governments in Hardee County. This is not a matching or reimbursement grant. The applications are open during the month of January and may only be offered this one time.

Manager's Meeting was held Wednesday morning.

Animal Control: Trina stated there have been dogs brought into the city and left here need to be trapped.

Police Department: Chief Scheel said it has been quiet and did not have much to report.

Public Works: Amy and her crew have been trimming trees around intersections to create more visibility. Christmas decorations are going up around city hall. The City of Wauchula will be helping with the Highway 17 lights this week. Ant traps have been placed at Centanino Park. Wayne had to replace the water hose on the trash truck. They will be pouring the slab on the Pole Barn this week.
