Request for Response- Repeat Audit Findings: We received a letter from The Florida Legislature Joint Legislative Auditing Committee date January 16, 2020. The audit report is in reference to Audit year 2017/2018. The issue is in reference to the number of adjustments for the yearend financial statement process. This has been mainly on that large dollar amount of grants the City has and how these grants were accounted for in the financial statements.

Mayor Spinks has sent a letter in response to the Repeat Audit Findings. Since the start of this current fiscal year. I have separated the grants from the operating budget. When invoices come to the City, I turn them over to Vicky who then records them. The invoices are paid out of the proper grant account in the budget in a timely matter once funds are received. Vicky and I have worked closely together on the grant issues and should reduce the amount of adjustments at the end of this current fiscal year. That means next year's audit will show the same issue as this year's audit.

Wastewater Plant Road Widening: The road widening at the wastewater plant was completed and passed inspection by Chief Walker on Monday.
