***Manager's Report 4/24/2020***

**Expense Report for March 2020:** We have reached the halfway point of the fiscal year. The General Fund revenues are at 57.73% left to collect and the expenditures are at 60.72% remaining in the budget. The Enterprise Fund revenues are at 48% left to collect and expenditures at 68.99 % remaining in the budget. We are operating above the average of 50%. Total revenues are at \$2,203,697.25 and expenses at \$1,990,646.84 leaving an excess of \$213,050.41.

**Police News:** There had been a series of car burglaries in Avion Palms this week. The Police have made an arrest as the result of citizen involvement and great police work.

**Southwest Florida Water Management District Water Use Permit – Water Loss Remedial Action Plan Report** has come back and reviewed by District Staff and was acceptable.



**Public Works:** I had Kyle on the tractor all week and mowing the burn pile, cemetery field and Hardee St. field. We had the guys put in a few meters and I ordered more meters and meter boxes for future replacement. I worked on a hydraulic leak on the backhoe. I had a callout for someone running over a hydrant on MLK/ Bertha Fulse.
