Nano Plant Update: I participated in a conference call with Tonka, Censtate, Inframark led by Pennoni. We discussed how to get to the end of the project and complete the following:

- As builts
- Providing manuals
- Water test
- Training
- Programming issues
- Warrantee

Based on Pennoni's opinion and the results of testing, the membranes were not damaged when chlorine was introduced to them. The daily log sheets for reporting needs to be done by Tonka and training for the operators on how to use these log sheets. This needs to be done so the warrantee is covered on the system. Tonka will be providing three more days of training to the operators starting November 30th. We are making progress.

Billing Clerk Interviews were held this week. We had around 40 applications and interviewed 6 on Wednesday. We had some great interviews, and we will be considering the next steps to move forward in the hiring process. Three were selected for a final round of interviews to occur today. We will proceed with background checks once we have selected from the list.

Public Works has started work at Pyatt Park to get ready for the Pyatt Park renovations. The fence around the ball field and backstop is down. They have also been working on the old pool house which will be turned into storage.

A H2A Housing project by Doug Battie will be constructed on Snelling once permits are approved at the Hardee County Building Department.
