

Request for Bid

City of Bowling Green

Train Depot remodel ADA compliant (Bathroom, expand doorways, and add ramp).

The City of Bowling Green is seeking written Bids from licensed and insured vendors with the required expertise and capability to perform the work or supply the commodities or equipment for: Remodeling Train Depot to ADA standards (Bathroom, Doorways, Ramps).

INSTRUCTIONS TO SUBMITTING ORGANIZATIONS:

All bids must be in a sealed envelope, plainly marked on the outside with "**Train Depot Remodel project**". Bids shall be submitted together with all supporting documentation enclosed.

The successful Vendor shall furnish all commodities, equipment, submittals, manuals, and incidentals necessary to complete the order as specified here in this Request for Written Quotations. Any deviations taken by the Vendor to the terms, conditions, or specifications of this RFQ shall be clearly stated and included as an attachment to the Quote Form provided by the Vendor.

SCOP of Work:

- Remodel two (2) bathrooms into one (1) that is ADA Compliant
- Make all doorways Bigger to reflect ADA compliance
- Add any necessary ramps to building to ensure ADA compliance.

Quotes must be on company letterhead with a date and signature of an authorized representative of the vendor and must include the following:

- Description of Items to Be Provided, including any specifications or certifications that are in excess of those listed above.
- All cost to complete the job
- Price must include shipping and/or delivery cost
- Warranty Information; and
- Estimated delivery time upon order submission

Bids will be received at Bowling Green City Hall, ATTENTION: M. Carmen Silva, City Clerk, until 2:00 pm local time on **August 26, 2022**. Submittals may be either mailed or hand delivered prior to the above deadline. Postmarks will not be accepted. Bids will be publicly opened and read aloud. It is the responsibility of the bidder to assure that bids are received at City Hall no later than the specified time and date. Submittals received after this date and time will not be accepted or considered.

The City reserves the right to waive any informalities or minor irregularities; reject any and all bids which are incomplete, conditional, obscure, or which contain additions not allowed for; accept or reject any bids in whole or in part with or without cause; and accept the bid which best serves the interests of the City. Pursuant to the requirements of Section 287, Florida Statutes, all qualifiers are subject to those provisions pertaining to Public Entity Crimes and the Convicted Vendor List.

Vendors submitting bids must participate in E-Verify.



ADA

Door is only 34 and 1/2 inches wide, doorway would need to be modified in order to meet the ADA 3ft or 36 inch requirements. This access point is the only one that currently has a ramp to enter the doorway.



ADA

In order to use this door as the entrance and ADA access there will need to be a ramp or proper sloping to access building. The door will need to be modified as well as it is not 36inch in width.



Bathrooms

Recommend one unisex ADA bathroom based on available space.



Emergency Exit Lights

Need to repair and or replace non-working exit lights



Emergency Egress

Doors needs to swing out for emergency egress also push bar or something similar.



Side Door

Need not an exit sign as this is locked at all times and cannot be accessed.
